Dear Mr. Jones:

The Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) received the petitions of G&J Ranch and Mesa Water LP (the Petitioners) on August 19, 2009. According to the petitions, the groundwater conservation districts in Groundwater Management Area 1 adopted their desired future conditions on July 7, 2009. A copy of Resolution No. 2009-1 of the Groundwater Management Area 1 Joint Planning Committee was provided with the petitions.

Based on the information provided with the petitions, the TWDB has determined that:

- 1) the petitions conform to the requirements of 31 Tex. Admin. Code § 356.43(b);
- 2) the districts in Groundwater Management Area 1 have adopted their desired future conditions;
- 3) Petitioners have provided the districts in Groundwater Management Area 1with a copy of the petitions at least 30 days before filing this appeal with the TWDB;
- 4) the substantive issues raised in the petitions have not been reviewed previously by the TWDB; and
- 5) no more than one year has passed since the districts adopted their desired future conditions.

Therefore, as all requirements for filing have been met, the TWDB acknowledges receipt of a reviewable petition.

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Any district in Groundwater Management Area 1 may, within 10 business days of receipt of this letter, request that TWDB review of the petitions be postponed for 60 days, pursuant to 31 Tex. Admin. Code § 356.43(d), to encourage consultation and resolution of the issues raised in the petitions. If a request is not received by the TWDB after 10 days plus 3 days to allow for mail, staff will proceed with a review of the claims presented in the petitions and the posting of a hearing on the petitions, in conformance with 31 Tex. Admin. Code § 356.44.
